## NOVICE STOCK

- No aftermarket ecu allowed.  
Exception: tune or reflash on stock ECU allowed.
- No engine modifications.  
Exception: Aftermarket valve springs/valve spring retainers, air intake and exhaust modifications allowed.
- No aftermarket supercharger or wheels allowed.
- No modifications to the fuel system.  
Exception: Aftermarket fuel pump and regulator allowed, stock injectors and fuel rail must remain.
- No race gas - only pump gas available from any local gas station.
- No hull modifications.
- No engine swaps.

- No turbochargers.

### For clarity:

No hull modifications - this means the original shape/design of the hull cannot be modified or be of different material. Handling modifications are allowed which includes: sponsons, ride plate, intake grate, pumps and props.

## MANDATORY ITEMS



To ensure participation in the 2025 CIWA National Tour and pass tech inspection, please ensure that you have the following mandatory items and tech inspect criteria in order:

## MANDATORY ITEMS

- **Helmet:** a properly fitting, full-coverage helmet with chin and mouth protection
- **Life vest:** a floatable vest in sound condition
- **Footwear:** closed toe booties or trainers
- **Gloves:** full or half finger coverage
- **Eyewear:** eye protective goggles
- **Wetsuits:** full body waterproof clothing
- **Kill switch:** marine emergency cut-off which can be attached to life vest
- **Handle bar padding:** properly padded and securely fasten
- **Back protectors:** motocross style brace
- **Tow loop:** attached to the front of the craft

## TECH INSPECTION CRITERIA



## TECH INSPECTION CRITERIA

- Hull and deck in good condition
- Steering in good condition
- Engine compartment in safe condition
- Fire extinguisher per team
- Appropriate race number decals

## APPROPRIATE RACE NUMBER DECALS

- The number(s) must comply with the required specifications this includes the number being presented in one of the two following backplate colors:
  - A black backplate with white numbers
  - A white backplate with black numbers

### 7.8 BOAT NUMBERING SYSTEM

#### 7.8.2

Race number backgrounds size minimums are as follows:

#### Racing No. Background Size

- One digit ..... 20cm (8 in.) high by 15cm (6 in.) wide
- Two digits ..... 20cm (8 in.) high by 23cm (9 in.) wide
- Three digits ..... 20cm (8 in.) high by 30cm (12 in.) wide

#### 7.8.3

- Racing numbers must be a minimum of 18cm (7 in.) high and spaced at least 13mm (0.50 in.) apart. Standard block-type numbers without shading or outlining must be used. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the numbers are easy to read.

#### 7.8.4

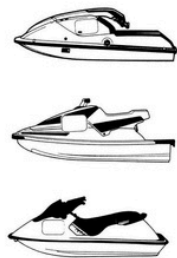
- If two or more riders using the same number enter the same class at the same event, all but one will be required to add a temporary letter suffix (e.g., "101A," "101H," etc.).

### Appendix – Racing Number Location

- Racing number backgrounds must be clearly located on the hull in the positions indicated for each model.
- Be careful not to place them in a location that will obscure them from the scorers (i.e., they should not be placed in the footwell or on horizontal surfaces).
- Only numbers can appear on the background.
